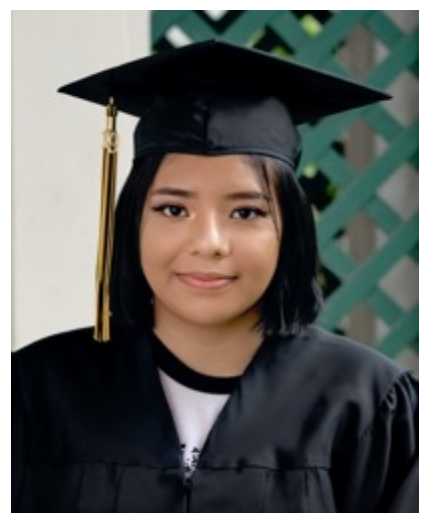

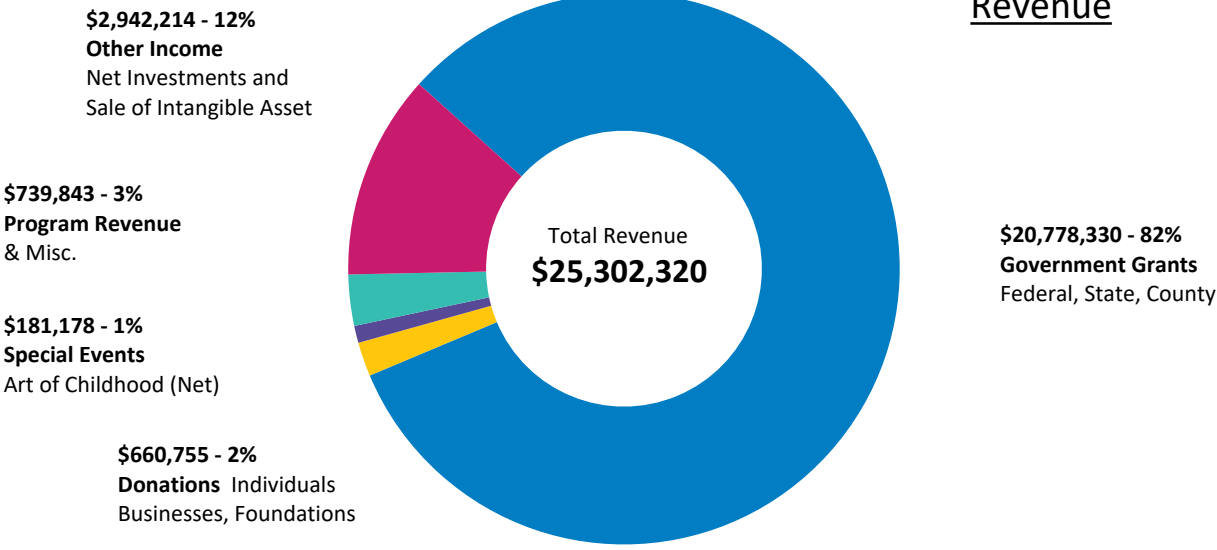

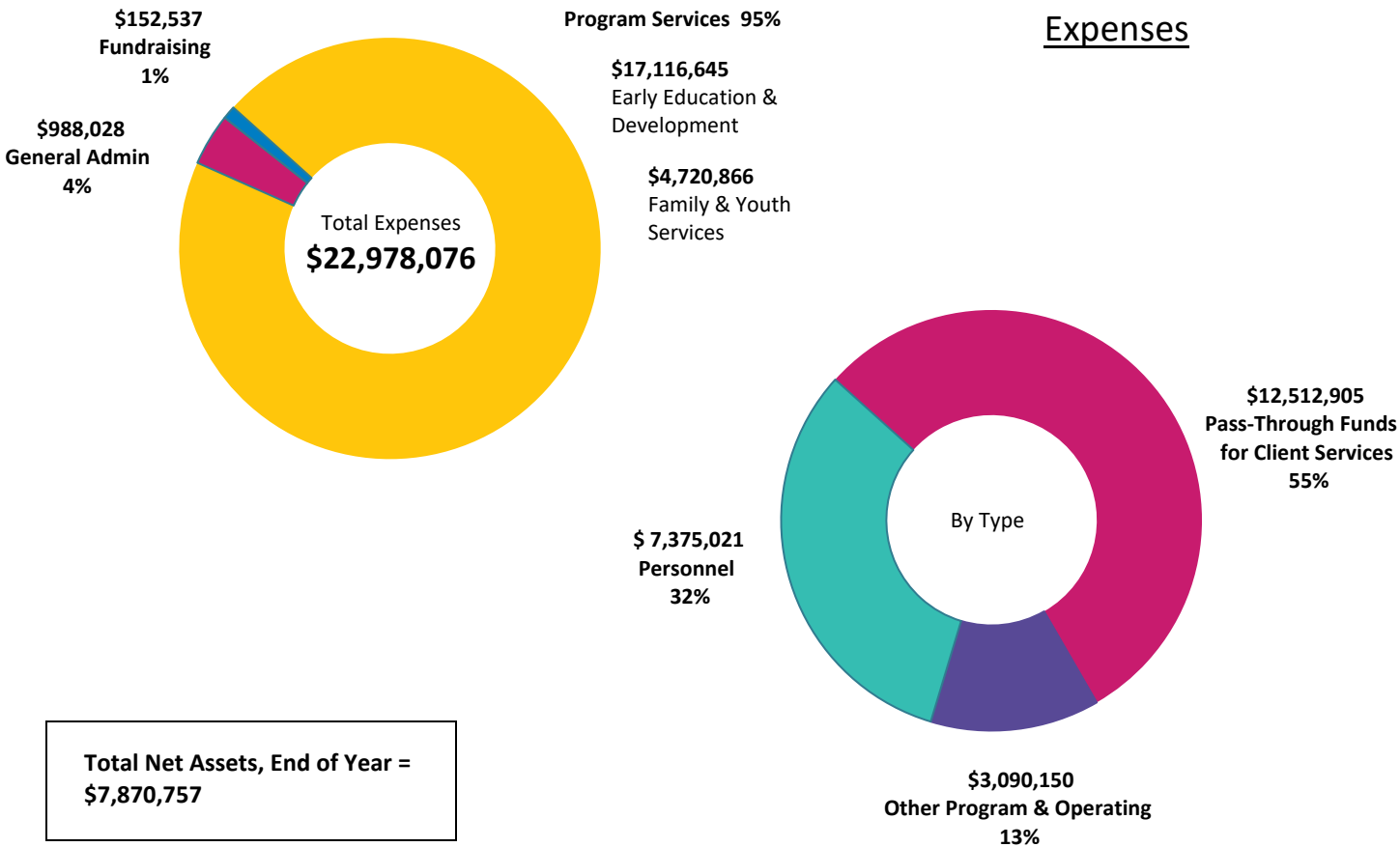
# Children's Cabinet Financials
