About The Children's Cabinet

The Children's Cabinet exists to keep children safe and families together by offering services and resources that address unmet needs through a unique and effective cooperative effort between the private sector and public agencies in Nevada.

Substitute Teacher Service

The Early Childhood Support Network (ECSN) offers substitute teachers in licensed child care centers and family child cares in the metro areas of Reno/Sparks/Carson City and North Las Vegas/Las Vegas/Henderson/Boulder City.

The Children's Cabinet employs a qualified team of early childhood educators. Our staff are fingerprinted and carefully screened. Teachers provide quality care by staying abreast on current child care research, including the Environmental Rating Scales (ERS), best practices, and regulations. Teachers often role model and collaborate to work with providers to reach a common goal of quality child care. Our staff are able to perform day-to-day tasks that are required in child care settings.

Training & Continuing Education

ECSN teachers are trained and certified in all initial and continuing requirements for caregivers working in licensed child care facilities including:

- ★ CPR
- ★ First Aid
- ★ Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases
- ★ Sudden Infant Death Syndrome
- ★ Recognition & Reporting of Child Abuse & Neglect
- ★ Child Development
- ★ Lifelong Wellness
- ★ Prevention of Shaken Baby Syndrome
- ★ Building and Physical Premises Safety
- ★ Emergency Preparedness
- ★ Medication Administration and Food Allergies
- ★ Transportation and Field Trip Safety

In addition, our teachers are Nevada Registry members and complete a series of continuous education training throughout the year.

How it Works

- ★ Providers must pre-register to use all ECSN Services. Call 775-856-0125 in northern Nevada or 702-513-8882 in southern Nevada to pre-register.
- ★ Call the ECSN hotline to request substitute services. Leave your name, number, days, and the hours you are requesting.
- ★ Messages are checked Monday-Friday 7:00 AM-9:00 AM.
- ★ Teachers are scheduled for a minimum of four (4) hours per day.
- ★ Child care facilities and family child care homes will be invoiced monthly and have 30 days to remit payment.
- ★ Cancellations must be made 2 hours prior to the scheduled shift.
